	Populations Receiving Long-Term Care.
Best Practice	West Virginia has implemented a color phased reopening plan ranging from Phase Red
Takeaways:	(active COVID-19 positive residents or positive residents within the last 14 days) to Phase
	Green (facilities that have progressed 14 consecutive days under Phase Yellow with no
	COVID-19 positives and no substantial community spread will enter Phase Green.).
	Reopening factors include: Community Prevalence, Cases in the SNF, Universal Source
	Control, Local Hospital Capacity, Access to Testing (baseline testing), Adequate Staffing
	(no staffing shortages), and Adequate PPE (contingency recommendations).
	Things to think about before you open: clear communication – how will you get your
	message out?; designate staff to be the 'point person' for your home; find the space –
	indoor and outdoor – for the visit; and set up an area for 'visitor kits' with instructions,
	PPE, and hand sanitizer.
