Point of Care (POC) Test Reporting Tool:

NHSN Groups will have the ability to see POC data via the POC data entry screen, in addition to the analysis option. More information about this will be provided in the POC Frequently Asked Questions document posted on the Long-term Care COVID-19 Module website https://www.cdc.gov/nhsn/ltc/covid19/index.html

NHSN Users will be alerted in the event that they try to enter a new individual who is duplicate to an existing individual in the NHSN system.

A confirmation message will be provided when deleting a staff/visitor from the NHSN system.

POC devices will be added to the system.

State Veterans Homes COVID-19 Tool

The NHSN Long-term Care Facility Component supports the nation's COVID-19 response through the LTCF COVID-19 Module. Facilities eligible to report data to NHSN's COVID-19 Module include nursing homes/skilled nursing, long-term care for the developmentally disabled, and assisted living. In response to H.R. 7105 – Veterans Healthcare and Benefits Improvement Act of 2020, NHSN created a surveillance tool to enable mandated reporting of resident and staff-level data to NHSN and the Veterans Health Administration (VHA).

As part of CDC's ongoing COVID-19 response, the State Veterans Homes COVID-19 Tool is designed to help long-term care facilities (LTCFs) track and monitor residents and staff who test-positive for COVID-19 (SARS-CoV-2). LTCFs eligible to report data include State Veterans Homes (SVHs) providing nursing home (LTC-SVHSNF) and domiciliary care (LTC-SVHALF).





Prevent Mistakes by Using the NHSN Tracking Sheets (Excel can be tricky)

- "Save As" and name the file with the new date each week.
- Use the drop down menu, for the **correct reporting week** .
- Use the drop down menu for the name of the vaccine.
- Don't type yes or no for the "vaccination series complete."

Prevent Mistakes

- Verify dates: admit, vaccination, discharge, hire date, etc to make sure dates are accurate. Wrong dates will create wrong vaccine rates.
- If you receive an error code when submitting, you need to figure out why. Your data is probably wrong.
- Your vaccine rates should not change much at from week to week, nor should they ever be <10%. Unless you discharged all your vaccinated residents and admitted only unvaccinated residents. You are reporting vaccine coverage for your current staff and residents.






