

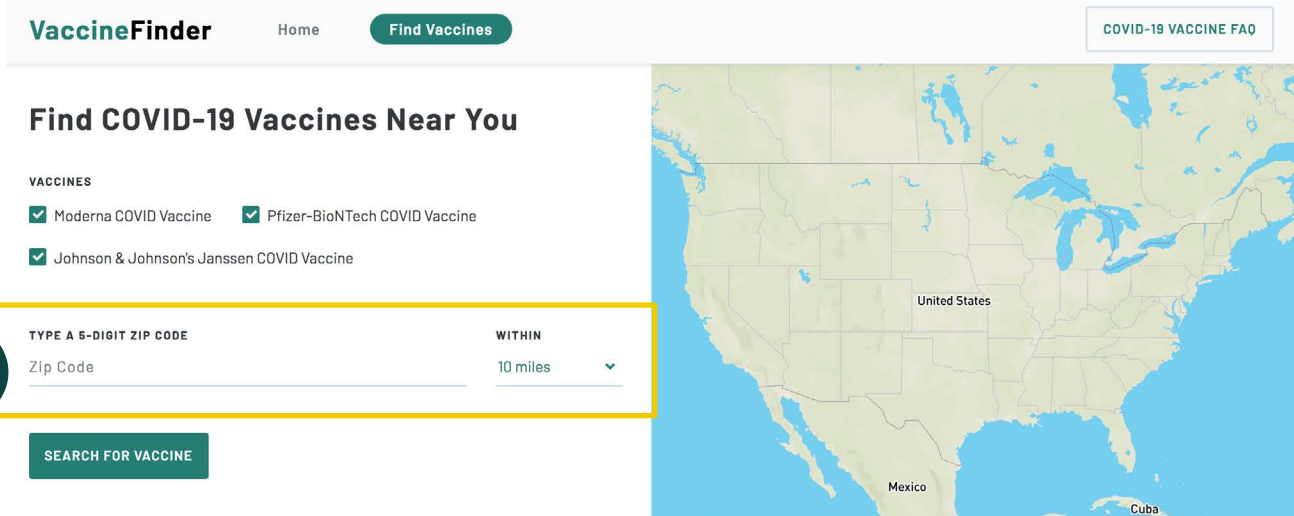


# VaccineFinder

A new website helps Americans find which vaccine providers in their area have COVID-19 vaccines in stock.

## How it works

Users enter their **ZIP code** to see inventory data from vaccine providers in their region.



Providers are requested to update their **COVID-19 vaccine stock data** from vaccine providers in their region.



*“The idea is to show where COVID-19 vaccine providers [are] that are open to the public — how to contact them, how to book an appointment, and try to show the daily inventory status so people are clear where there’s vaccine and where there isn’t,”*
