Person with a substance use disorder
Infant with Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome (NAS)
Has an [alcohol/drug] use disorder
Person with an alcohol use disorder
Abstinent
Substance-free
Substance-exposed infant or substance-affected infant
Actively using
Testing positive for substance use
Person who uses drugs
Regular substance use
Person who is new to drug use
Resumed/experienced a recurrence
Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT)
Person with opioid use disorder
Medications for Addiction Treatment (MAT)
Pregnant woman with opioid use disorder
Non-medical use of a psychoactive substance
Person who uses drugs for nonmedical reasons
Person in recovery
Substance use disorder
Person with a substance use disorder
Mother with a substance use disorder
Substance use / non-medical use
Prenatally exposed to [drug name]
