	Top Ten Interventions	Action Plan
1	Focus on comfort of patient: Comfort scale vs. pain scale.	
2	Consult CSRS/PDMP prior to continuing or prescribing new opioids.	
3	Outpatient prescription for Naloxone for all patients discharged on opioids.	
4	Dispense Naloxone to all patients who are prescribed an opioid in the ED.	
5	Have a minimum of one non-opioid PRN pain reliever on patient profile if patient is prescribed a PRN opioid.	



	Top Ten Interventions	Action Plan
6	Dispense 'Do's and Don'ts of Pain Medicines' to patients receiving an opioid at discharge.	
7	Targeted screening for Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) via ORT/ SOAPP-R, or NIDA – Modified ASSIST-SBIRT.	
8	Alert primary care of positive OUD.	
9	Initiate urine drug testing prior to prescribing opioids.	
10	Structured process for referral to substance use, mental health treatment, and Peer Support Services.
