

Sepsis: SPOT THE SIGNS

An infection with any combination of the following symptoms could mean sepsis, a medical emergency:



Confusion or disorientation



Fever, shivering or feeling cold



Shortness of breath



Fast heart rate



Extreme pain or discomfort



Clammy or sweaty skin

**Act fast if you suspect sepsis.
Seek medical care immediately!**
