Both you and your loved ones should stay up to date on Vaccines.



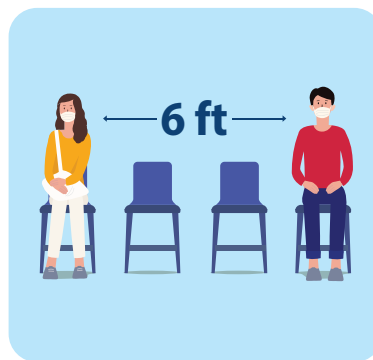
Wash your hands often.
