CORE PRINCIPLES TO FOLLOW WHILE IN THE FACILITY



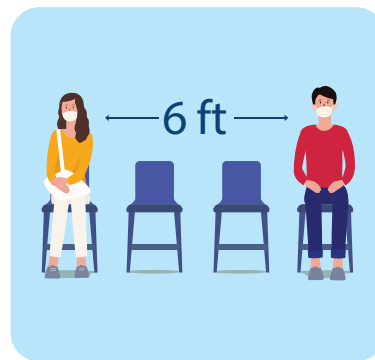
**Wash your
