

Event Description:

Your hospital has been selected to participate in a six-month patient safety cohort to improve **sepsis shock and/or sepsis mortality** and associated performance metrics. Alliant HQIC will hold kick-off calls in May and June to provide an overview, timeline and describe action periods for the cohorts. After the call, your quality improvement advisor and subject matter experts will provide 1:1 coaching and education for your hospital teams. At the conclusion of the cohort, hospitals will share accomplishments and success stories with each other. Hospitals are encouraged to participate in two, possibly three patient safety cohorts over the next six months.

Kick-Off Call Objectives:

- 1. Provide an overview of the patient safety cohorts, timeline and team expectations
- 2. Discuss the importance of baseline data and target goals for each cohort
- 3. Share quality improvement tools and resources to be used in1:1 coaching during action periods
