SUMMARY:

Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) has claimed nearly 500,000 U.S. lives in the last two decades as accidental overdoses are the leading cause of death for people under age 50.

Social determinants of health (SDoH) risks which include socioeconomic and environmental factors, as well as individual health-related behaviors, are responsible for approximately 80% of health outcomes. Addressing the SDoH can help to prevent opioid addiction and decrease overall overdose deaths, while improving the lives of individuals with OUD.

1. Understand the key terms of “social determinants of health” and “opioid epidemic” and their impact on healthcare.
2. Explore the relationship between social determinants of health and the opioid epidemic
