

Am I Up to Date?



Anyone 5 years and older is considered “Up to Date” with COVID-19 vaccinations if they have received one 2023-2024 updated Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, or Novavax COVID-19 **monovalent mRNA vaccine**.



Those over age 65 or moderately or severely immunocompromised may get additional doses of updated COVID-19 vaccines for added protection.

The 2023-2024 updated monovalent mRNA vaccine was introduced on Sep. 12, 2023. If you have not received the updated vaccine, you are **NOT** “Up to Date.”

NOTE: The 2023-2024 updated monovalent mRNA COVID-19 vaccine more closely targets the XBB lineage of the Omicron variant.
