- Learn all you can about a kidney transplant, the benefits, and the types of kidneys available. Work with your care team to create a care plan that is right for you.
- Find a transplant center that best fits you. Each transplant center has specific criteria you must meet to be considered for a transplant.
- Take control of your health and your journey. Take the lead and be the CEO of your health.
- Stay positive! Do not give up if your journey does not go as you planned.
