# Part 1: Hospital Commitment to Health Equity (HCHE) Measure

Hospitals will attest to the Hospital Commitment to Health Equity measure via the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) system.

Domain 1

Equity is a Strategic Priority

Leadership Engagement

- This HCHE measure applies to all hospitals participating in the Hospital Inpatient Quality Reporting System.
- There are five domains in this measure. Each domain is worth one point, for a total of five possible points.
- Hospitals <u>must attest to ALL elements of a domain</u> to receive the one point, so attest "YES" if you're doing any of this work.
- Reporting on HCHE is MANDATORY for CY23, and the submission period is April 1, 2024, - May 15, 2024.

   . On the dashboard on the left-hand side of the screen, click "data submissions" and then "structural measures."
- CMS will publicly report the scores.
- Payment determination will be decided in FY25.

# Screening for Social Drivers of Health Measure

- Food insecurity
- Housing instability
- Transportation needs
- Utilities difficulties
- Interpersonal safety

Numerator

Number of patients who were screened for **one or all** social drivers

Denominator

Number of patients 18 or older admitted as an inpatient

# Screen Positive Rate for Social Drivers of Health Measure

- Food insecurity
- · Housing instability
- Transportation needs
- Utility difficulties
- Interpersonal safety

Numerator

Number of patients who screened positive for each driver

Denominator

Number of patients 18 or older admitted as an inpatient and screened for social drivers

- Reporting for this also occurs in the <a href="https://hqr.cms.gov/hqrng/login">https://hqr.cms.gov/hqrng/login</a> and it's listed under the HCHE measure.
- Reporting on the screening for SDOH is voluntary for CY23 and the submission period is April 1, 2024, - May 15, 2024.
- Exclusion Criteria:
  - Patients who opt out of screening
  - Patients unable to complete the screening and have no legal guardian or caregiver to do the screening on their behalf or patients who died during admission.
- Screening is mandatory in CY24 with reporting in CY25.
- Payment will be determined for this measure in FY25.



# Attesting to SDOH-1

#### SDOH-1 Numerator & SDOH-2 Denominator

The number of patients admitted for an inpatient hospital stay who are 18 years or older on the date of admission and are screened for all of the following five HRSNs (food insecurity, housing instability, transportation needs, utility difficulties and interpersonal safety) during their hospital inpatient stay. \*

Ex. 0,1,2,B,...,99999999

#### SDOH-1 Denominator

The number of patients who are admitted to a hospital inpatient stay and who are 18 years or older on the date of admission. \*

Ex. 0,1,2,3,...,99999999

Note: For this part, you will only submit one (1) value for the numerator and one (1) value for the denominator for the entire year.



## Attesting to SDOH-2

#### SDOH-2 Numerators - Health related social needs

#### Food insecurity

The number of patients admitted for an inpatient hospital stay who are 18 years or older on the date of admission, who were screened for all five HRSN, and who screen positive for food insecurity. \*

This field is required \*

Ex. 0,1,2,3,...,99999999

#### **Housing instability**

The number of patients admitted for an inpatient hospital stay who are 18 years or older on the date of admission, who were screened for all five HRSN, and who screen positive for housing instability. \*

This field is required \*

Ex. 0.1,2,3,...,99999999

#### Transportation needs

The number of patients admitted for an inpatient hospital stay who are 18 years or older on the date of admission, who were screened for all five HRSN, and who screen positive for transportation needs. \*

This field is required \*

Ex. 0,1,2,3,...,99999999

#### **Utility difficulties**

The number of patients admitted for an inpatient hospital stay who are 18 years or older on the date of admission, who were screened for all five HRSN, and who screen positive for utility difficulties. \*

This field is required \*

Ex. 0,1,2,3,...,99999999

#### Interpersonal safety

The number of patients admitted for an inpatient hospital stay who are 18 years or older on the date of admission, who were screened for all five HRSN, and who screen positive for Interpersonal safety. \*

This field is required \*

Ex. 0,1,2,3,...,99999999

#### Notes:

- You will submit five (5) unique numerator values (i.e., a value for food insecurity, a value for transportation etc.).
- You will NOT need to submit a denominator value because that is pulled directly from your SDOH-1numerator submission on the last slide.
