## COVID-19 is not gone.

People are still getting COVID-19.



- Everyone aged 5 years and older should get one dose of the 2023-2024 updated COVID-19 vaccine.
- People aged 65 years and older who received one dose of any updated COVID-19 vaccine should receive an additional vaccine at least four months after the previous dose.
- People who are moderately or severely immunocompromised may get additional doses of the updated COVID-19 vaccine.
