FACILITATOR GUIDE

This facilitator guide is designed for use with the Alliant Health Solutions Immunization Jeopardy PowerPoint Game. This game can highlight areas of focus for additional education, training and program development.

Please make sure game is in presentation mode (⏮) and started on the first slide to start the game. Dollar amounts under the categories are 'clickable.'

Since this exercise is designed for education and to generate discussion about potential opportunities for continued program development, there are questions where multiple answers are acceptable responses.

Facilities with multiple locations can use this game as a company-wide activity to promote the importance of immunization throughout the year.

Resources needed:

- Computer with projection TV or screen (in the absence of technology, game boards could be printed and distributed)
- Facilitator
- Score keeper, scoring sheets or play money to determine winners.
- Rewards for winning individuals, teams or responses.
